Bringing Theatre to Life

RB Productions is a nonprofit community theatre organization known statewide for our workshops, masterclasses, mainstage shows and summer youth theatre. Although some of our programs include adults our primary focus is on providing training, education and live theatre opportunities for youth.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT FOR YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULTS

RB Productions (RB) theatre programs are extremely beneficial to youth, especially those who may not have similar programs available to them in local schools. Participants build valuable skills in stage performance, self expression and public speaking. They are encouraged to try new things and take risks, taught how to handle success and failure, and learn how to support and encourage others in their efforts. RB's programs help youth develop a sense of pride and accomplishment and create opportunities to learn about theatre from coaches, directors, peers and visiting Broadway professionals — an opportunity not commonly found at community theatres.

RB also gives young adults employment and volunteer opportunities that may not be available to them through local schools and colleges. For those who are considering a career in theatre — actors, directors, choreographers, costumers, stage managers, lighting managers, and sound technicians — RB Productions provides a great way to gain real-life work experience.

COMMUNITY BENEFITS

RB Productions theatre programs are strong community-building activities.
There is a collaborative and supportive

relationship between youth participants, the adults who teach and mentor them, volunteers and parents. In addition, organizations such as the Capitol Center for the Arts, other regional theatre programs, area music schools, dance studios, teachers, businesses and individuals come together to provide training, financial support and other resources that help make our programming and shows successful.

By supporting RB Productions programs you make a contribution to the community by supporting the local artistic culture and helping build the creative economy. You also help us bring educational theatre programs and cost-effective quality entertainment to the region.

QUALITY PROGRAMMING HAS A COST

Although RB Productions does charge for program participation and show tickets, keeping our youth theatre experience affordable is very important to us and to the families and children we serve.

To keep prices as low as possible we budget conservatively and leverage free or low-cost resources (sharing storage space / borrowing costumes) as much as we can. Our summer staff is minimal and many are college students who receive closely monitored part-time salaries. Even with these measures, program fees and tickets only cover approximately 50% of our real costs.
