

Although RB Productions is a community theatre, we are professional in our operation. We are known statewide for the quality of our intensive summer youth theatre productions, master classes, professional development workshops and mainstage shows. Most of RB's programming takes place at the Capitol Center for the Arts, the largest and most successful performing arts center in the region.

The RB summer youth theatre musical programs are popular, fun, and highly regarded by the general public and participating families. Because they are in demand, it is not uncommon for some youth productions to be at full enrollment within the first 24 hours of registration.

By the end of 2016, RB Productions mainstage participants have presented 9 shows and youth theatre participants have presented more than 40 shows, each one involving an average of 35 youth. This means that RB Productions has had over 2,300 participants to date!



The RB Productions youth theatre was launched in 2004 to provide a safe and supportive environment for youth ages 7–18 to experience and enjoy various aspects of live theatre. Our summer youth theatre



### AT A GLANCE:

- Participants have been drawn to the RB youth theatre program from numerous NH cities and towns and several states.
- Youth theatre camp enrollment and show attendance has more than tripled since it first began.
- Approximately half of RB's youth productions are adjudicated, an evaluation process that recognizes outstanding actors, directors, and technicians (choreography, music, costuming, etc.).
- To date RB has provided over 20 need-based scholarships for attendees in summer camp programs. (Need for scholarships exceeds availability and demand is high.)
- Over the years RB Productions has received a number of New Hampshire Theatre Awards including the **Children and Youth** Theatre Award (Clint Klose, Director) and the General Excellence Award for Community Theatre. (RB staff and summer program participants also consistently place in the top rankings for youth theatre statewide.)

### PARTICIPANTS HAVE GONE ON TO:

- Return to their own theatre programs and schools with greater confidence and skill.
- Pursue degrees in theatre, stage management, artistic direction, dance and choreography, acting and musical theater.
- Work for Disney and on Broadway in NYC.
- Participate and place in regional and national competitions and receive theatre scholarships to colleges and universities.
- Work in theatres throughout the state, enriching regional culture.
- Direct theatre programs of their own.
